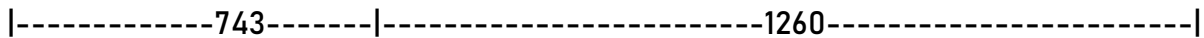
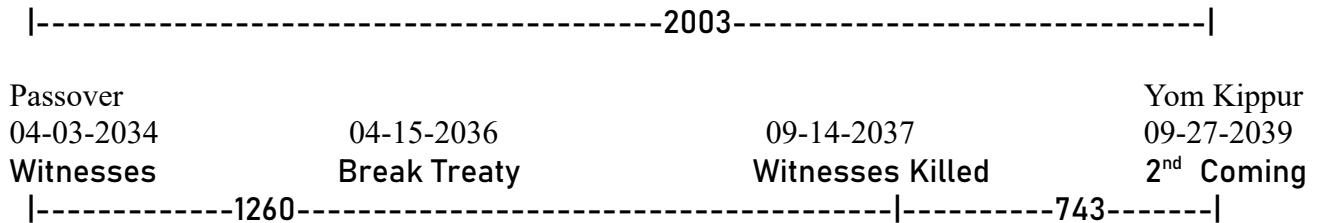


The Witnesses

Without getting into here which dates came from where, there are 2003 days from the Witnesses starting until the Second coming of Jesus into Jerusalem.

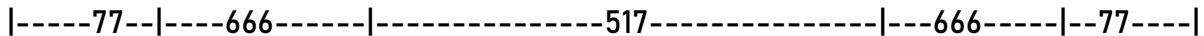
From the starting of the Witnesses until their death is 1260 days, Rev 11:3-7. That leaves 743 days until the Second coming. $2003 - 1260 = 743$.

Similarly, from the Breaking of the treaty with Israel until the Second coming is also 1260 days, Rev 11:2. And so there is another 743 days from the Witnesses until the Breaking of the treaty.



Notice that $2003 - 743 - 743 = 517$.

Notice that $743 = 77 + 666$.



In the Section on the Flood, there are 46 days until the Flood period starts. Then there are 40 (days and nights), 110, 104, 60 and 57 days = 371 days.

Notice that $743 = (2 \times 371) + 1$. This means that each 743 days contains two Flood periods, for a total of four Flood periods for the two sets of 743 days.

There is no evidence as yet that these Flood periods or the 77 days and 666 days determine specific events in the 743 days. They certainly get your attention.

There are $3 \frac{1}{2}$ days where the Witnesses are killed just after the 1260 days. The one day in the 743 is the $\frac{1}{2}$ day plus the rest ($\frac{1}{2}$) of that day. Rev 11:7-12.

So the one day occurs 4 days AFTER the death of the witnesses at 1260 days and is the resurrection of the Witnesses and all other Christians alive or dead. The 743 days is $3 \frac{1}{2}$ days, $\frac{1}{2}$ day, and 739 days. The one day is also Yom Kippur, 10 Tishri, the day the Reign of Jesus begins.

For the other 1260 days, the one day occurs 4 days BEFORE the Breaking of the treaty with that 4th day before also broken into halves. The 743 days here are 739 days, $\frac{1}{2}$ day, and $3 \frac{1}{2}$ days. This one day is Passover, 15 Nisan, the day the 5th Seal martyrs are given robes.

So far, the two 743's are mirror images of each other.

Now consider the 517 days. From the first ½ day which is Passover, it is 50 days until Pentecost where the Abomination will occur.
Rev 8:1 says that the 7th Seal is silence in heaven for about a half hour. The whole Tribulation of 2520 days is referred to as "the day of the Lord".
2520 days / 48 half hours per day = 52.5 days. So 50 days is "about" a half hour of that day.

From the Breaking of the treaty until Pentecost is $50 - 4 = 46$ days. Remember from above there were 46 days before the start of the Flood. So then $517 - 46 = 471$ days. That is precisely 100 days more than a Flood period. So there are five Flood periods.

In the Trumpet judgments, the first 4 Trumpets have 1/3 of most things destroyed. At this point all but 57 days of the Flood period could have been used.

The 5th Trumpet has those without God's seal being tormented for 5 months = 150 days.
The 6th Trumpet has 1/3 of men killed. The earth is claimed. There are 7 Thunders.
The Witnesses are killed.

If the 57 days are broken into 50 days and 7 days, then the left over 100 days can be added to the 50 making them the 150 days of the 5th Trumpet. Then the 7 remaining days could be the 7 Thunders.

The 7th Trumpet would be the second half of the second split day (Yom Kippur). Here the Witnesses are taken to heaven. Jesus begins His Reign.

Notice that the $517 \text{ days} - 150 \text{ days} - 7 \text{ days} = 360 \text{ days}$ exactly. 360 days is a "Time".
Times are used to measure punishments. Time, Times and ½ a Time = 1260 days, Rev 12:14.
This "coincidence" further verifies the 150 days followed by 7 days.
